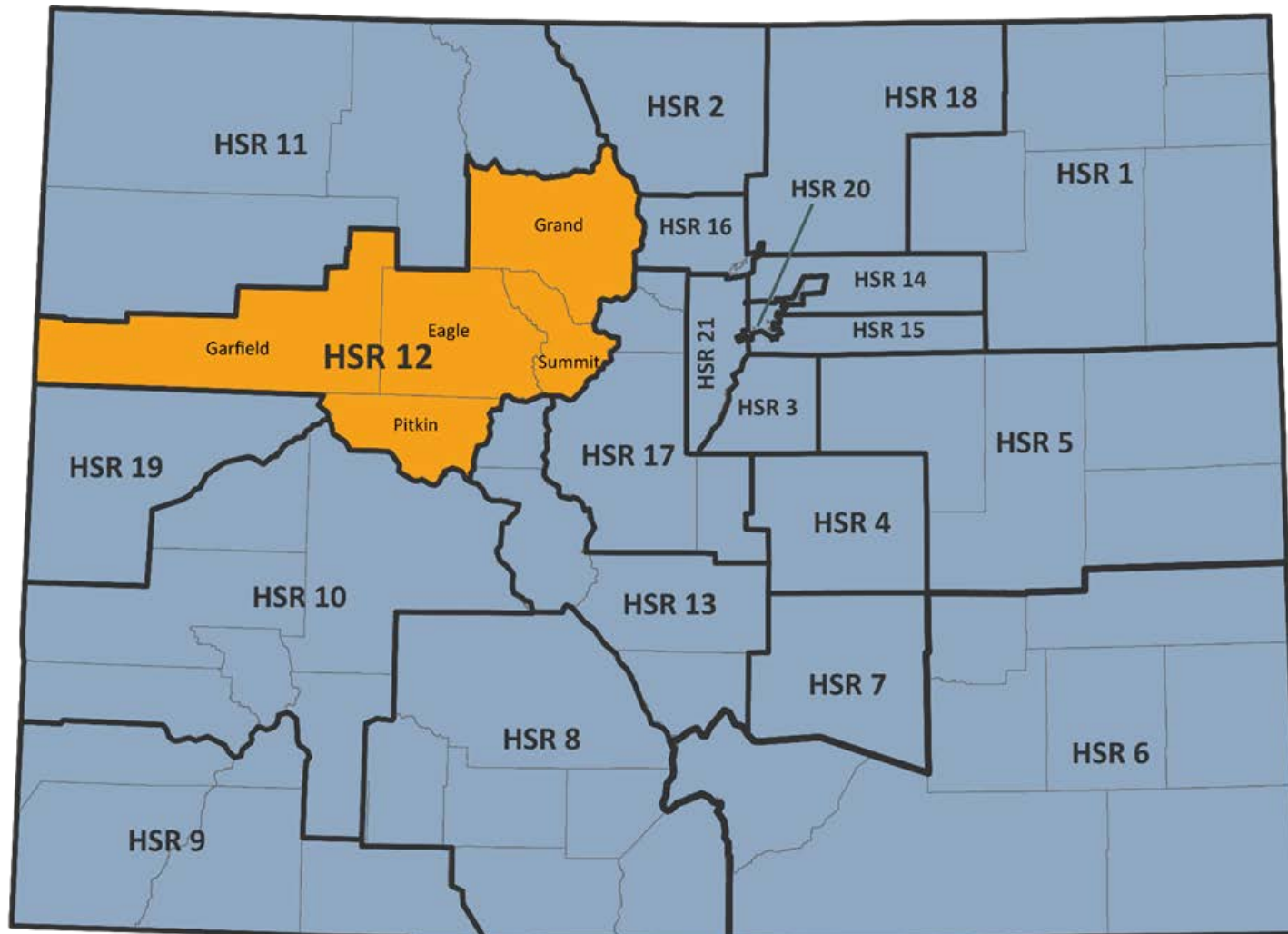

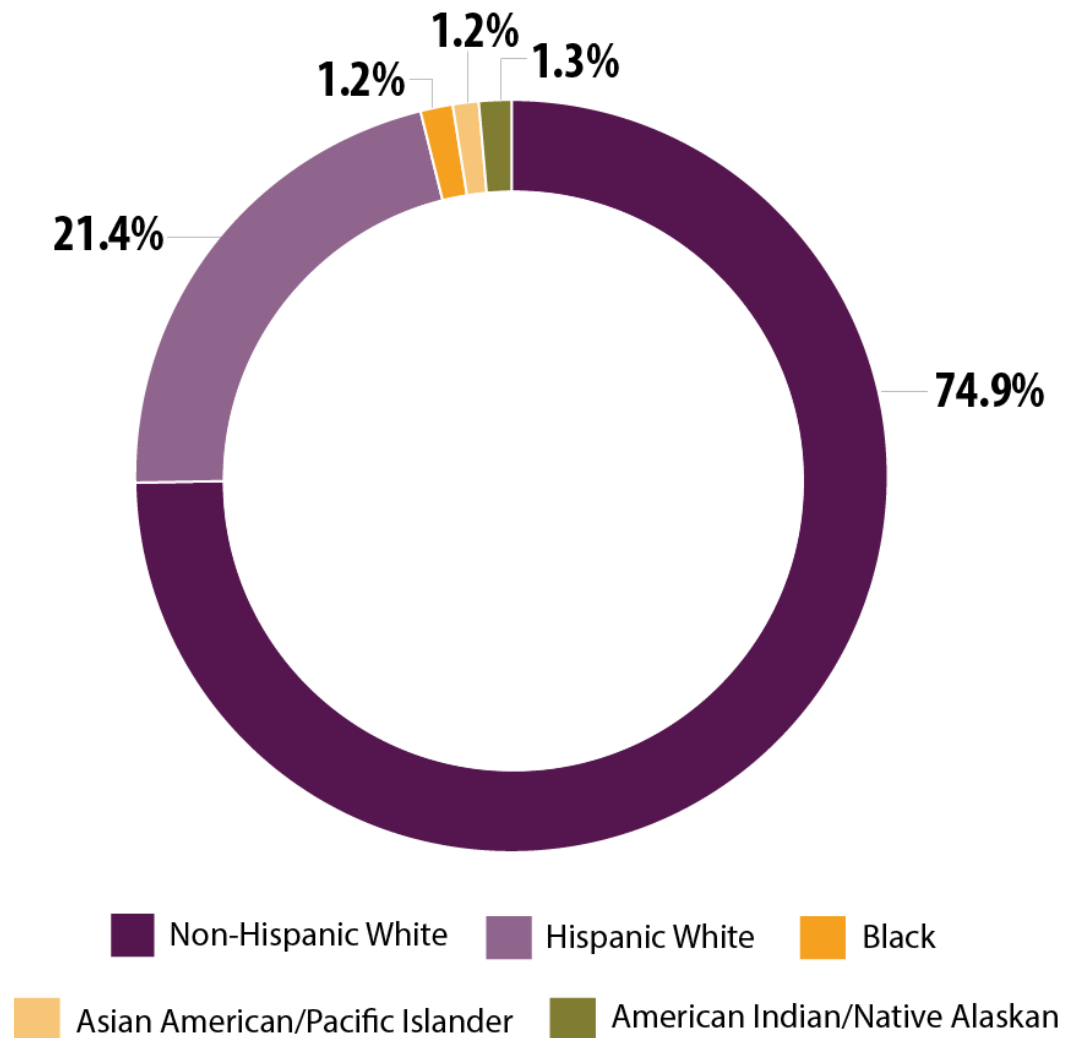

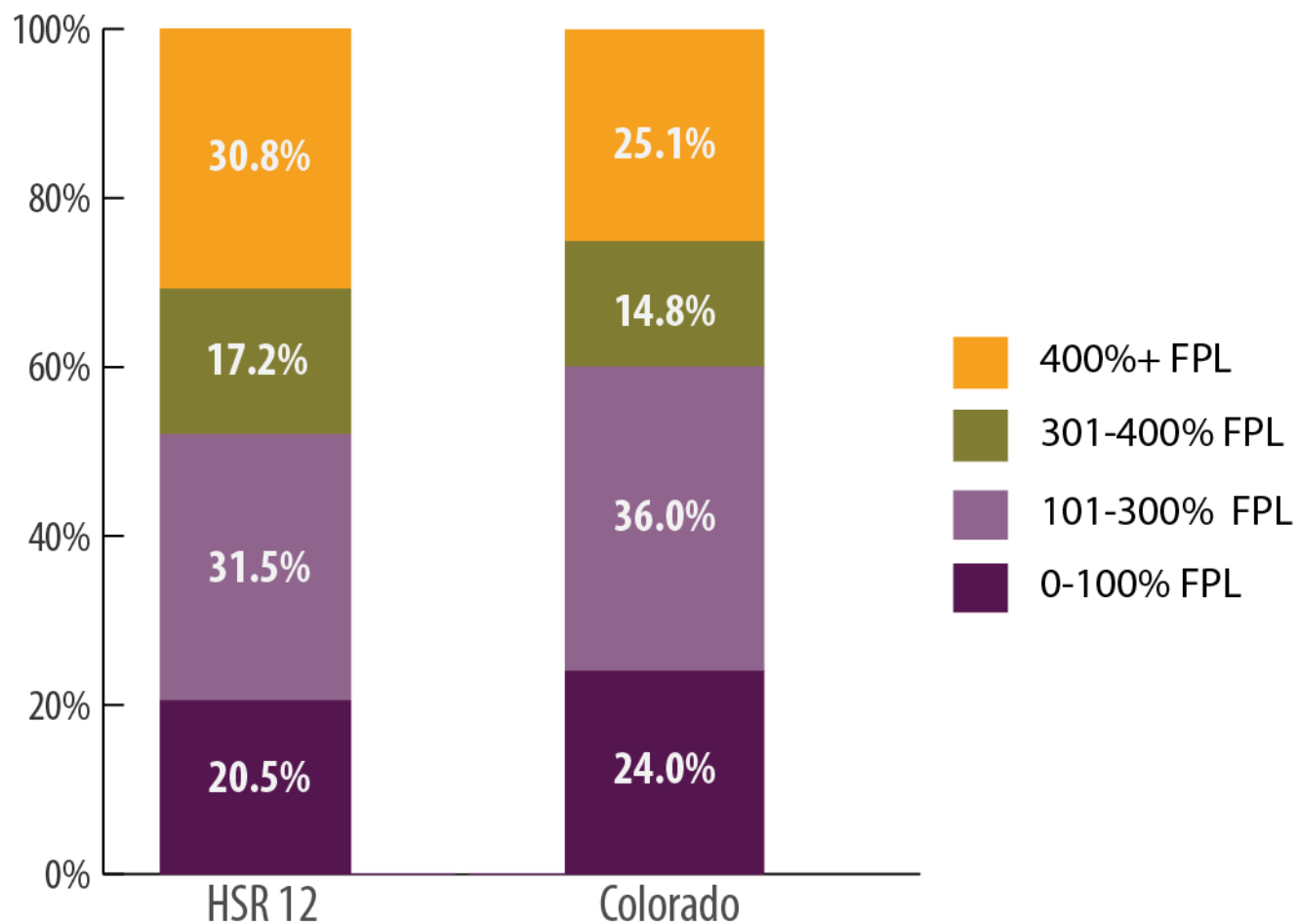

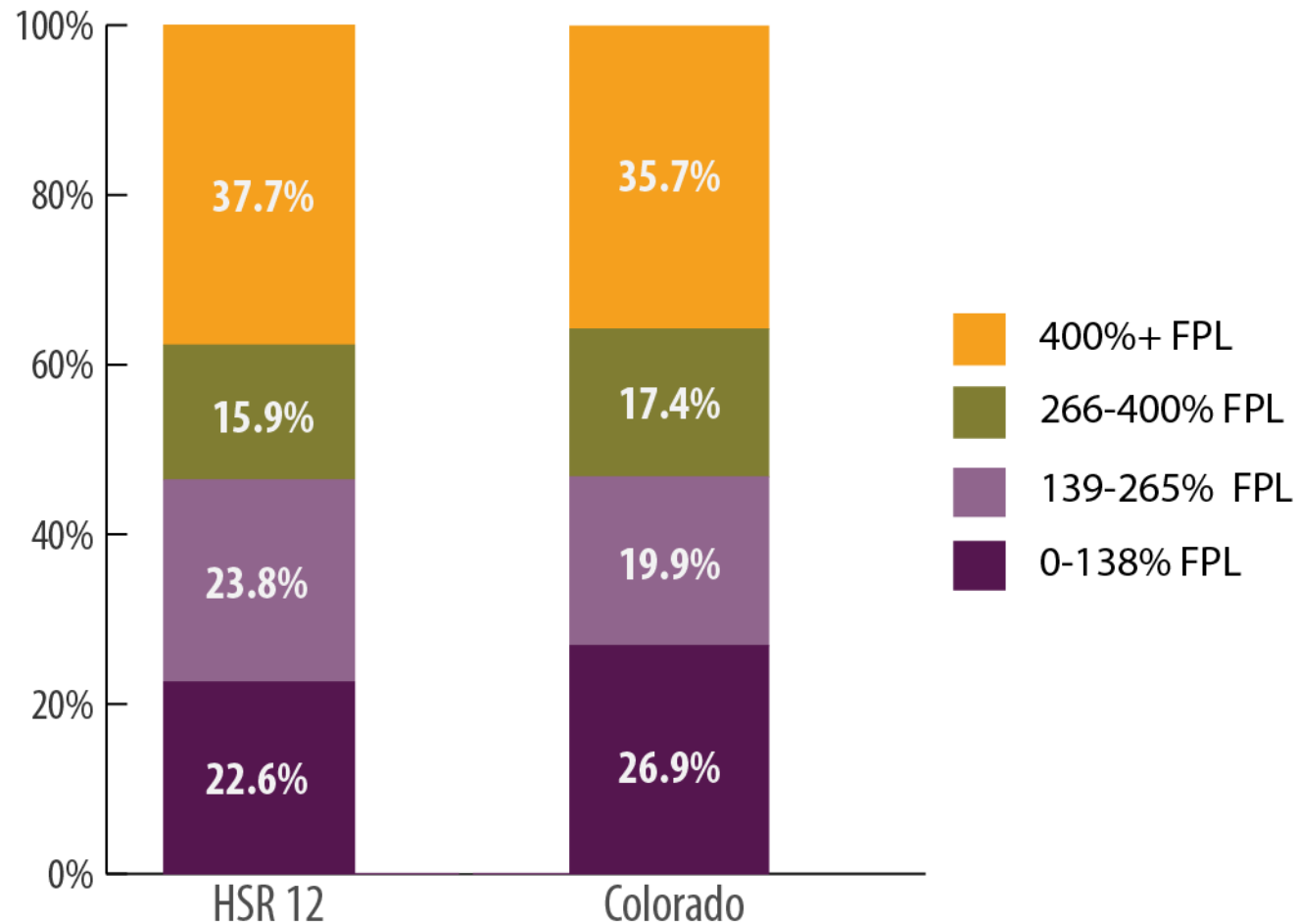
HSR 12: Race and Ethnicity

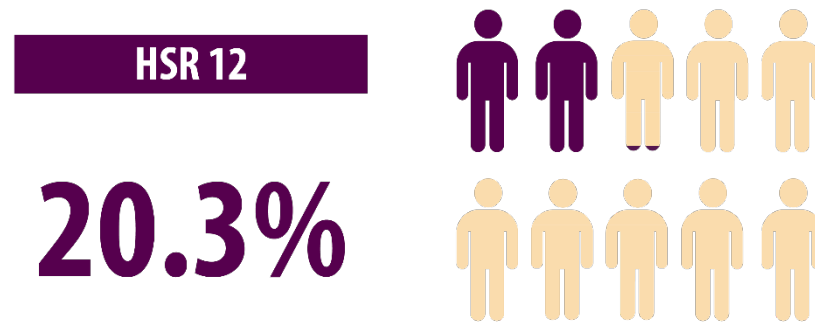

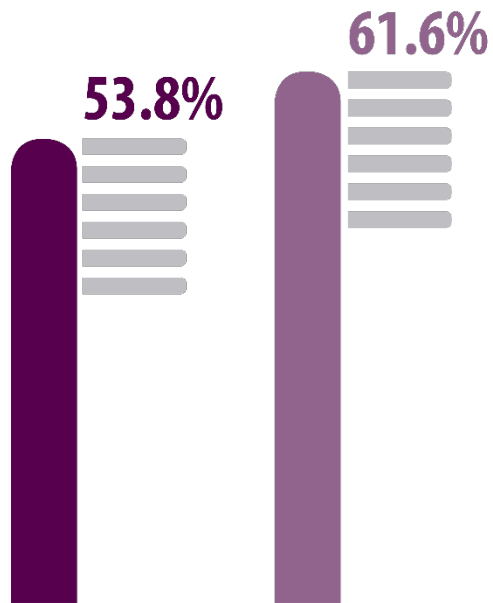

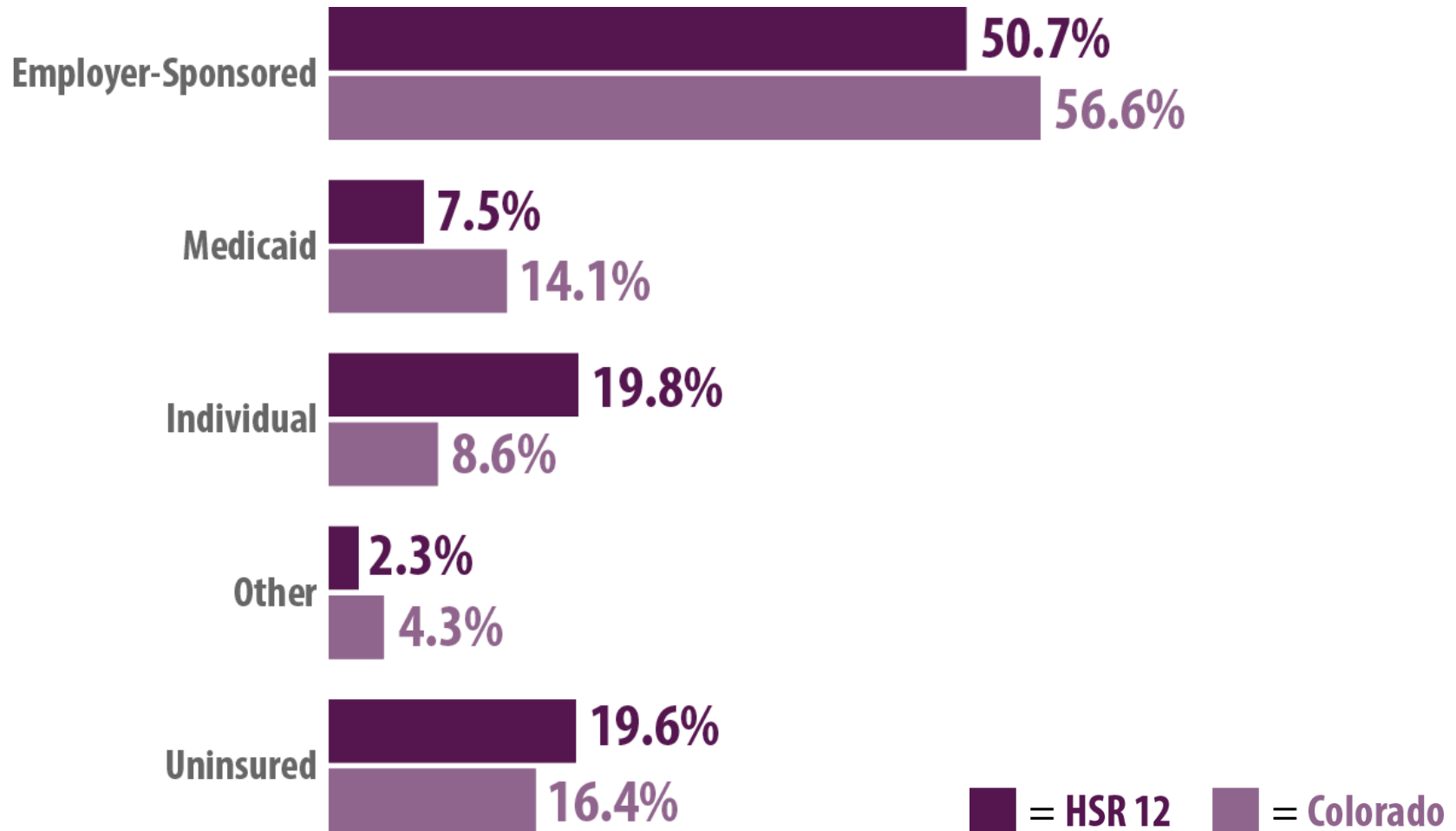

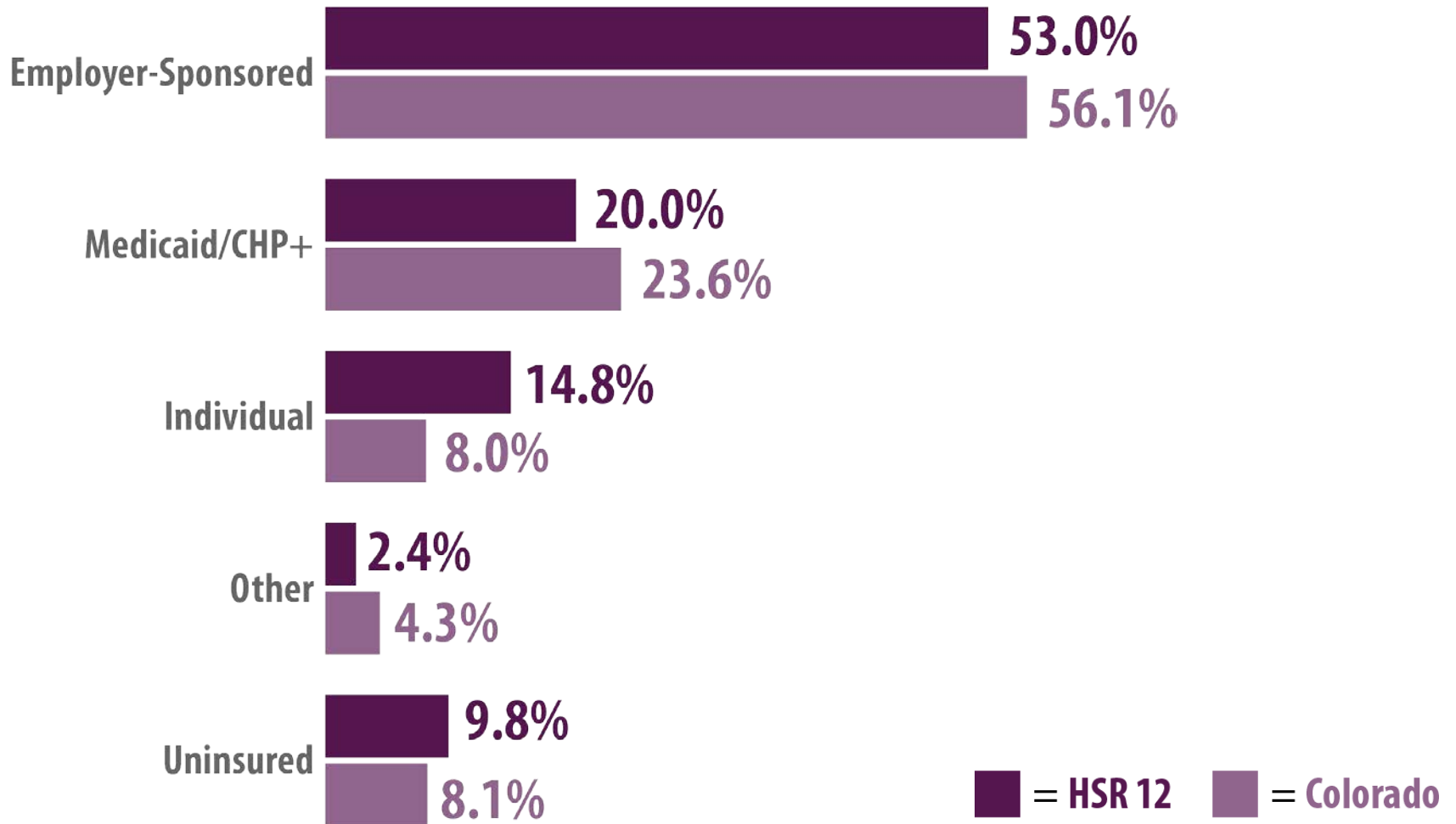

HSR 12: Health Insurance Types, 2012



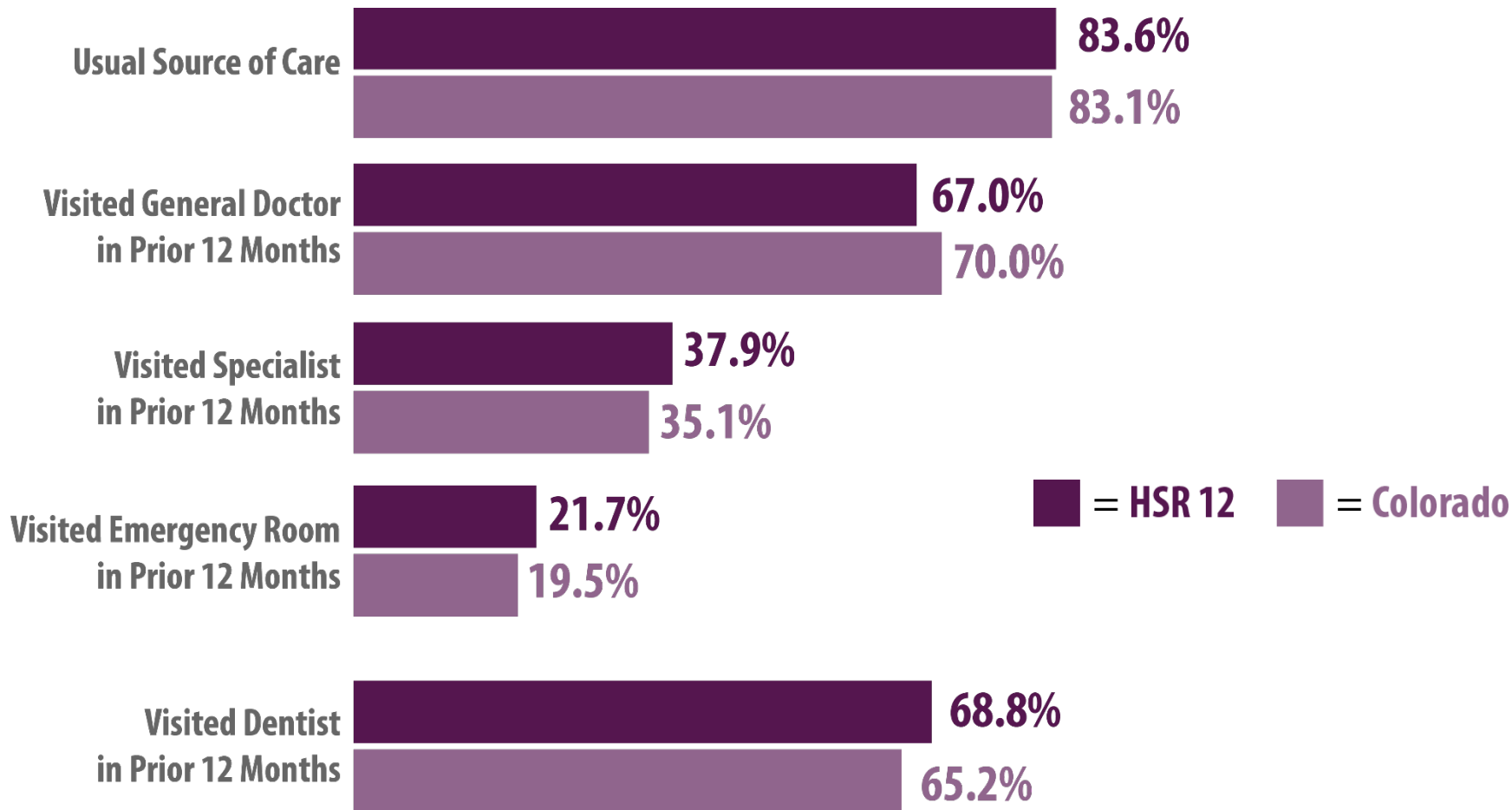
HSR 12: Health Insurance Projections, 2016
