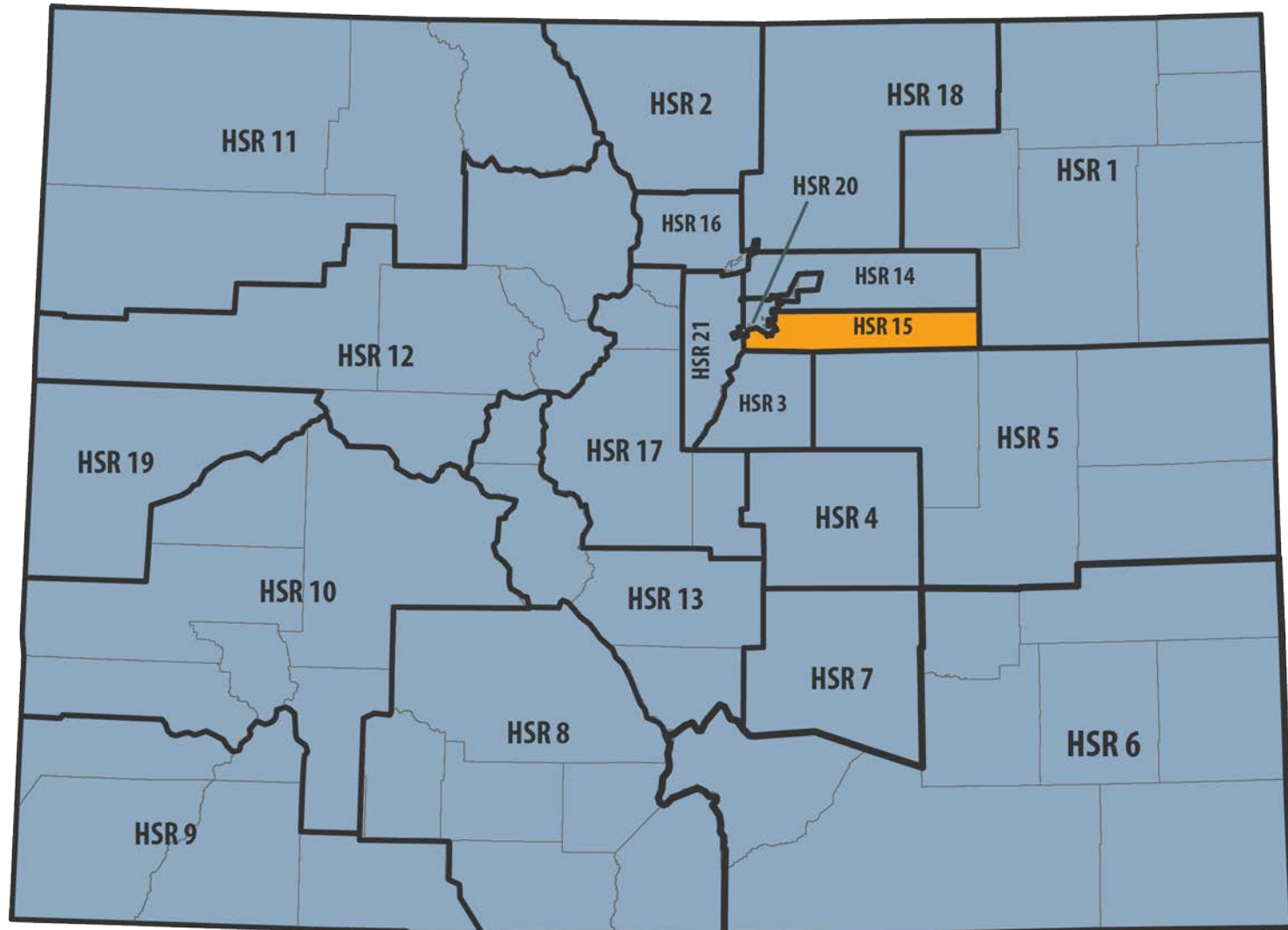

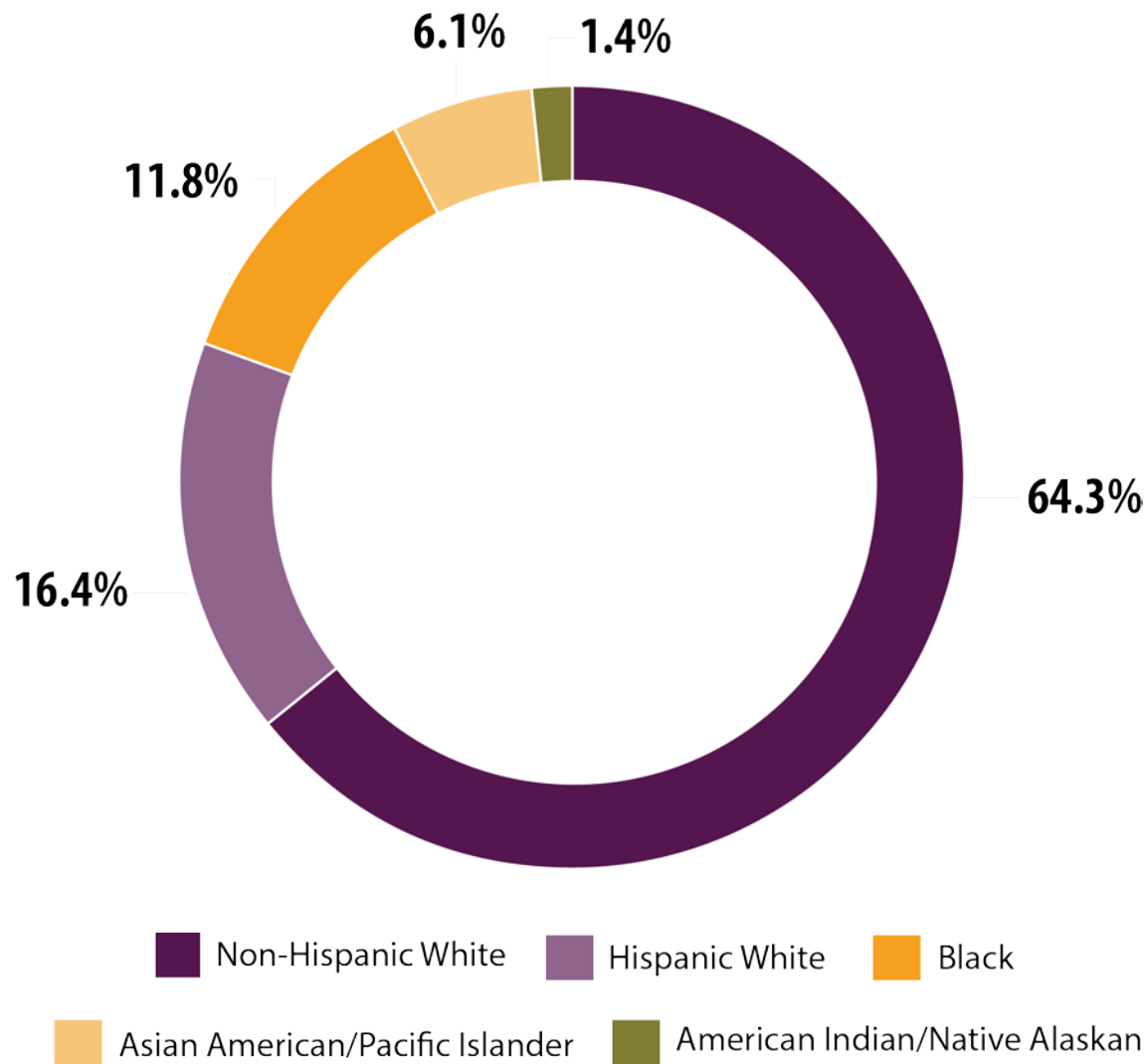

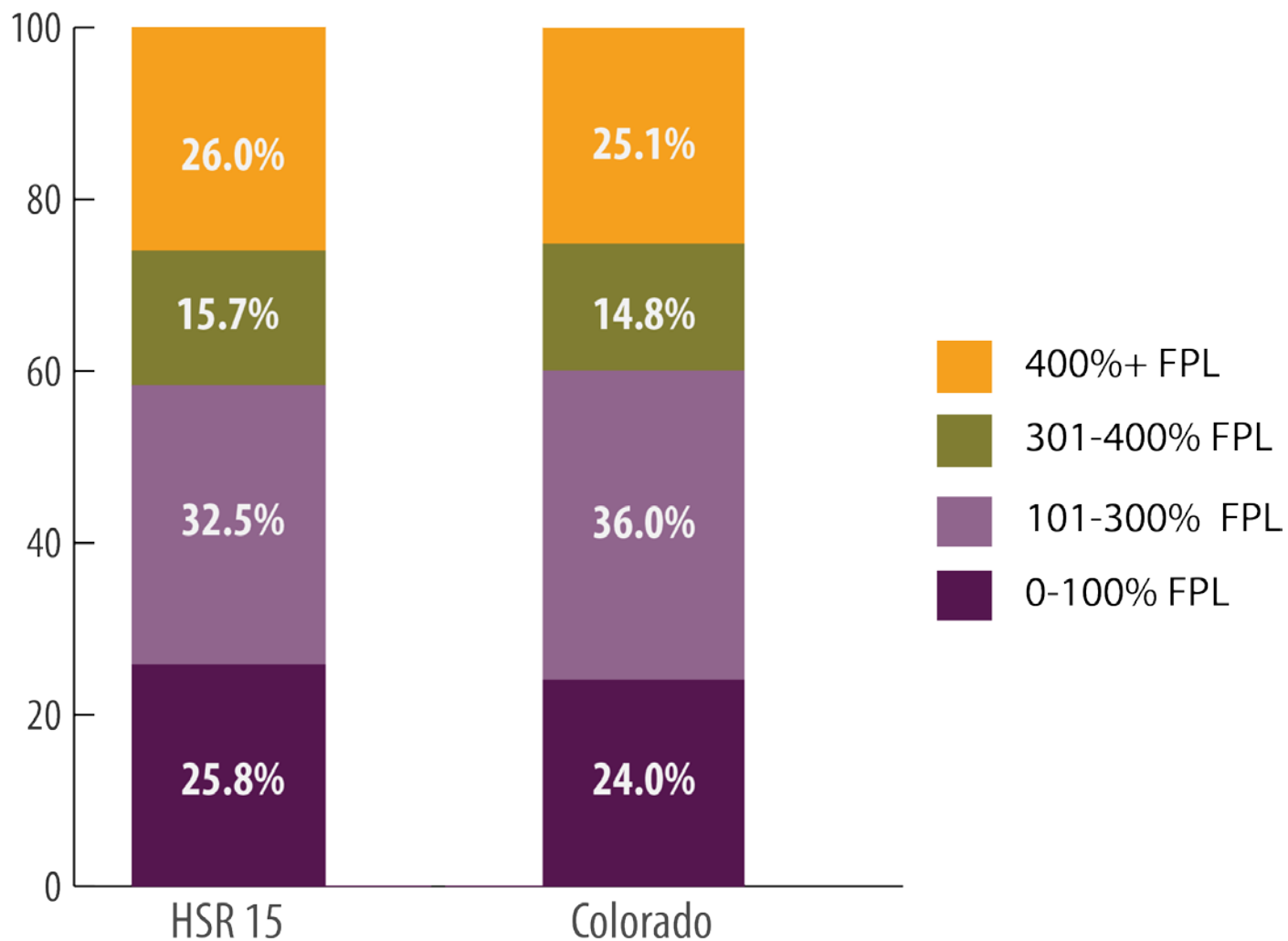

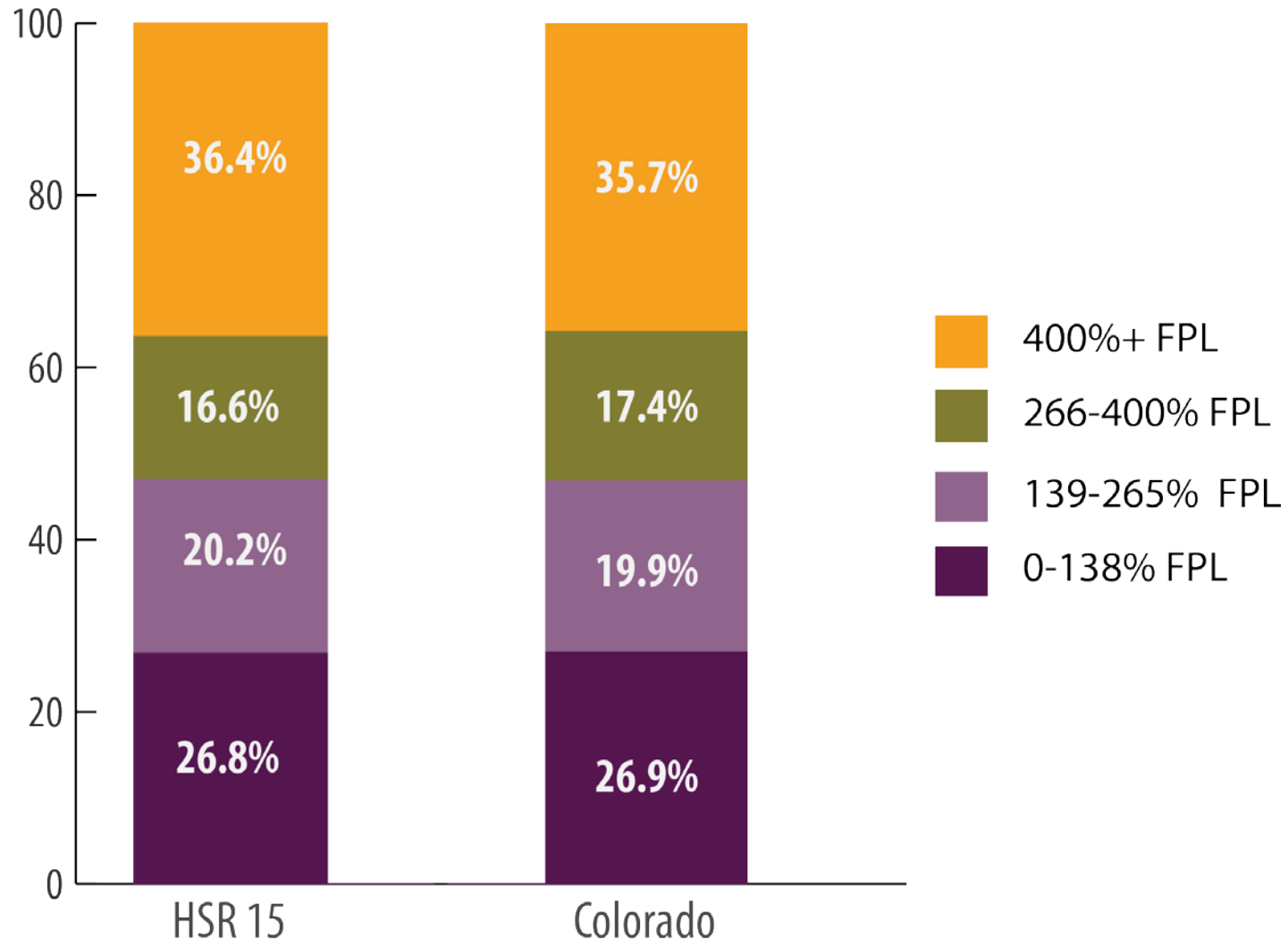
HSR 15: Race and Ethnicity

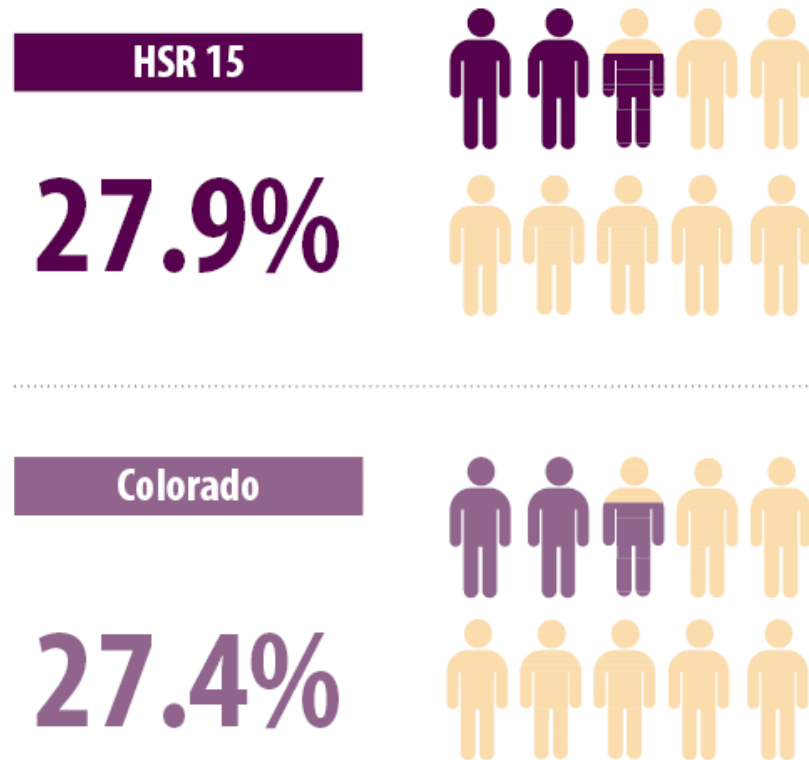

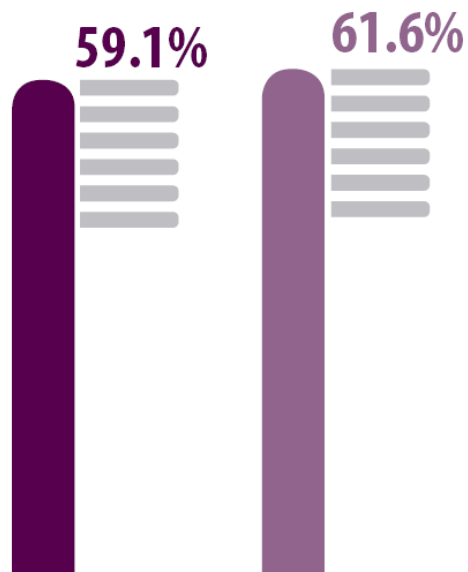

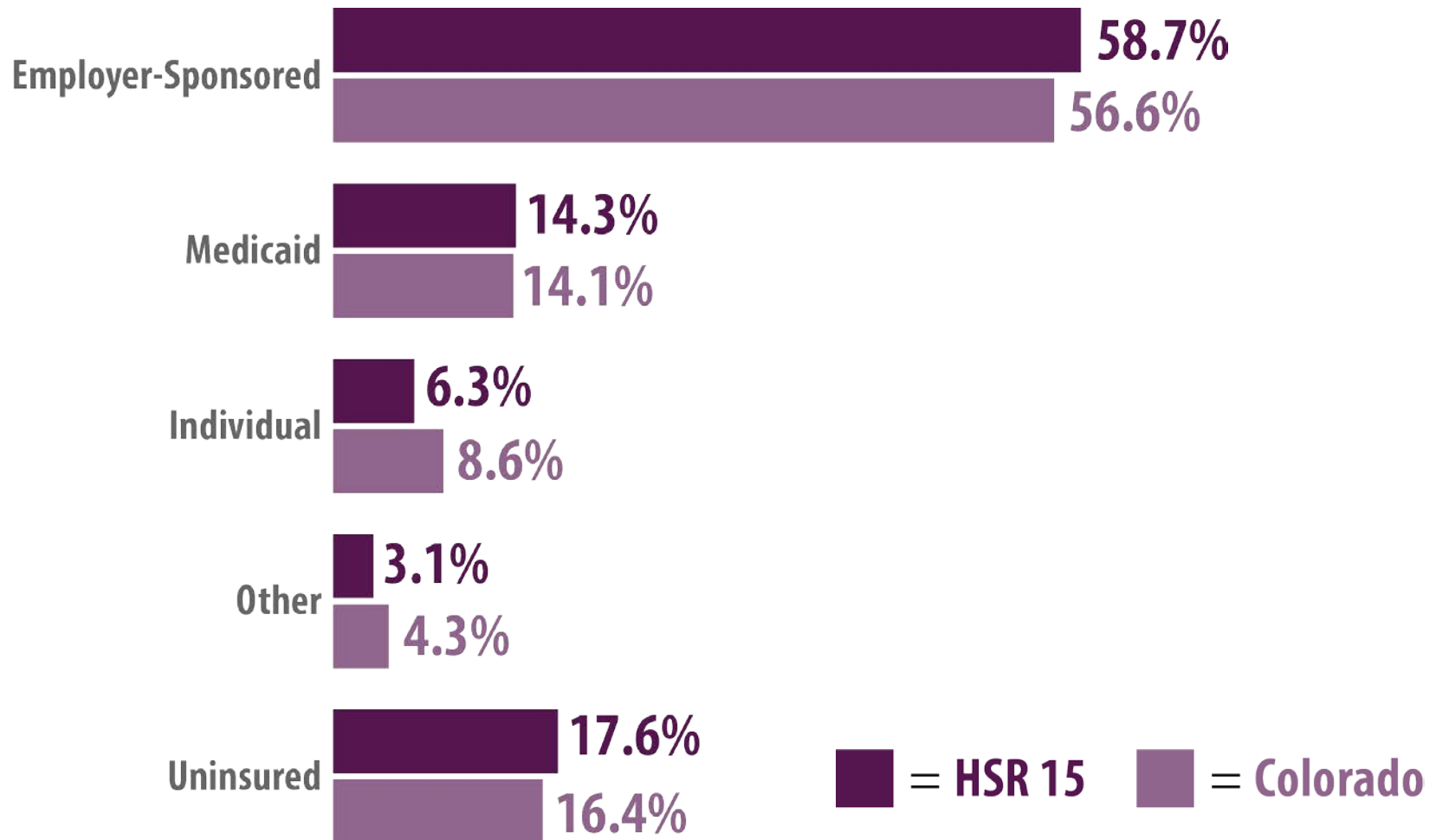




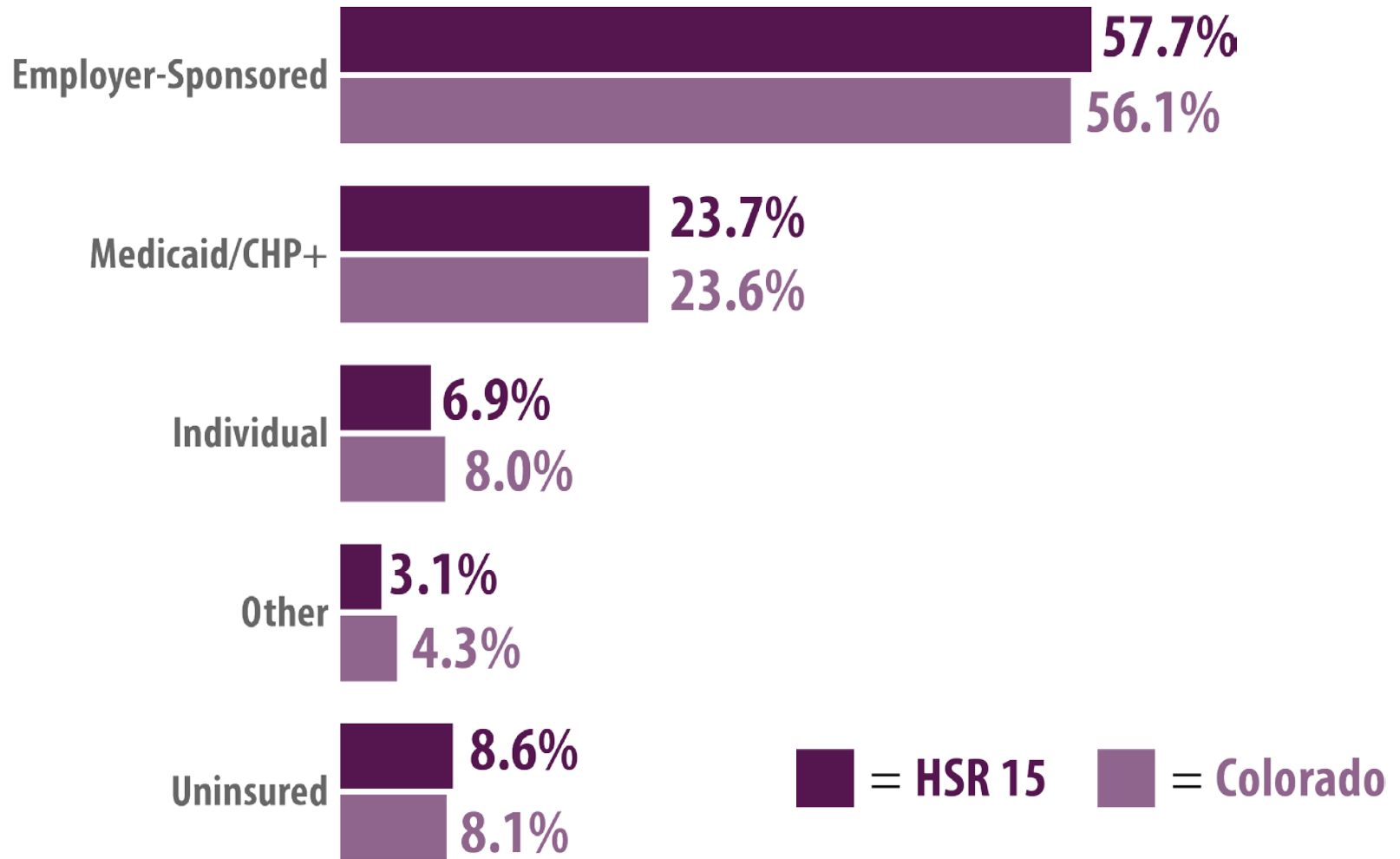

HSR 15: Health Insurance Projections, 2016

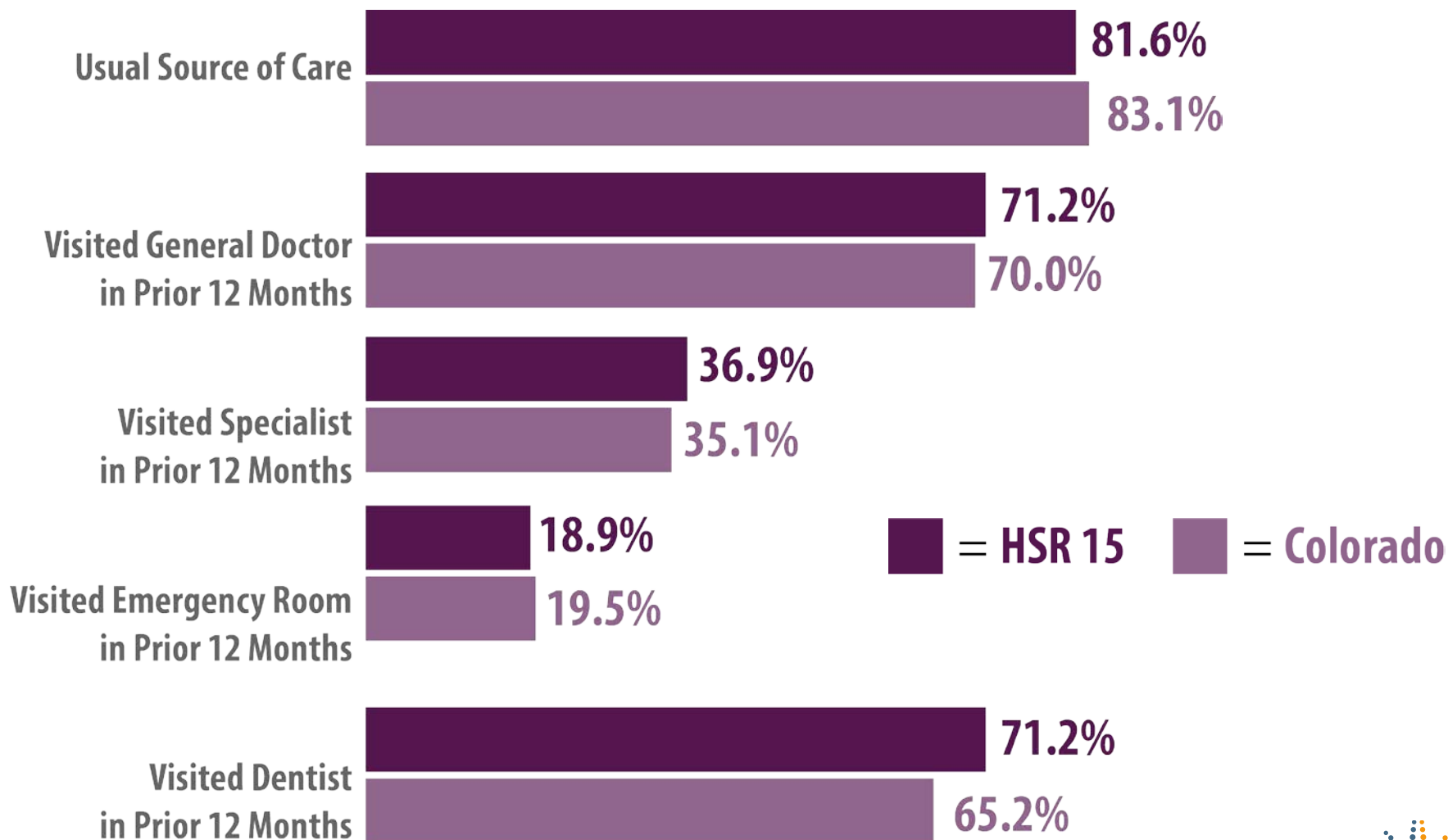
