

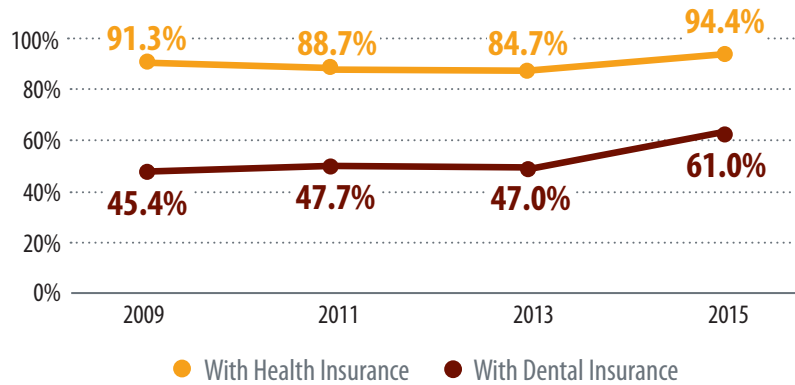

With Insurance, 2009-2015

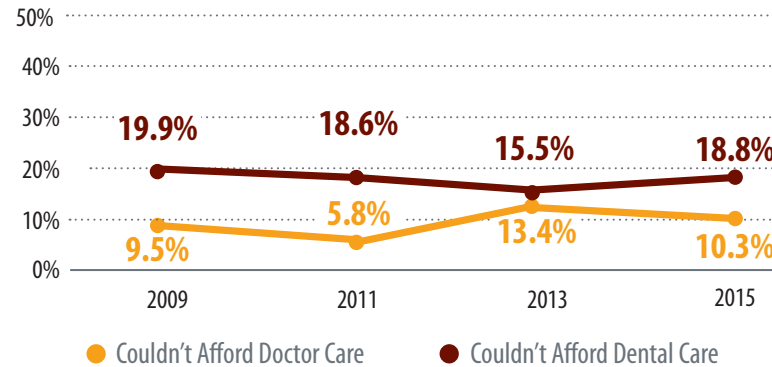


Barriers to Care

Index Score **8.8**

But many obstacles make it hard for people to get health care – even if they have insurance.

Couldn't Afford Medical or Dental Care in Past 12 Months, 2009-2015



In Past 12 Months ...

- Couldn't afford a prescription **12.4%**
- Couldn't afford specialist care **10.0%**
- Couldn't get a doctor appointment when needed **20.6%**
- Didn't have a usual source of care **12.4%**
- Provider wouldn't accept insurance **9.3%**
- Didn't get needed mental health care **8.7%**
- Didn't seek care because uninsured* **29.8%**
- Didn't go to doctor due to lack of transportation **8.0%**

Realized Access

Index Score **6.4**

When people obtain preventive services, it's a good indication they have access to care. But hospitalizations or emergency room visits may indicate inadequate access.

Preventive Care

Well-child visits in the past year for those under 19 years



Received prenatal care in first trimester **84.5%**

Pap test in the past three years for women aged 18+ **74.8%**

Mammogram in the past two years for women aged 50+ **76.9%**

Colonoscopy or sigmoidoscopy at any time for people aged 50+ **61.7%**

Visited a dentist or dental hygienist in past year, all ages



Avoidable Care

Of those who went to the ER, went for a condition that could have been treated by a regular doctor **55.4%**

Hospitalized for uncontrolled diabetes, adults aged 18+ **1.8***

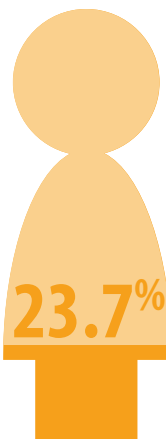
