










Numbers of Uninsured Coloradans, 2009-2015














The Drop in Uninsured is a Story of Medicaid Expansion

Changes in Health Insurance Coverage, All Ages, Larimer County, 2013-2015




Employer-Sponsored Medicare Medicaid/Child Health Plan Plus (CHP+)



Uninsured Rate by Health Statistics Region, 2015










Uninsurance is Down, but Underinsurance is Up














More Larimer Residents are Skipping Care Because of Cost

Percentage of Larimer County Residents in the Past Year Who Did Not ...













CHAS: How It Was Fielded



Who: 10,136 randomly selected households

What: Twenty-minute telephone survey

When: Between March 2 and June 26, 2015

Where: Statewide, divided among 21 Health Statistics Regions

Why: To gather information that can inform policy-making and help measure health reform efforts
