


























The Drop in Uninsured is a Story of Medicaid Expansion

Individual Market (Including Connect for Health Colorado) Uninsured









Uninsured Rate by Health Statistics Region, 2015





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

Uninsured Rates by Age, Mesa County, 2015














Uninsurance is Down But Underinsurance is Up





Underinsurance in Mesa County, 2013-2015






Gains in Coverage Have Not Resulted in Better Access to Care






Skipping Care Because of Cost, 2013-2015

Increasing Barriers for Mesa Residents, 2013-2015









Who: 10,136 randomly selected households

What: Twenty-minute telephone survey

When: Between March 2 and June 26, 2015

Where: Statewide, divided among 21 Health Statistics Regions

Why: To gather information that can inform policy-making and help measure health reform efforts
