












Numbers of Uninsured Coloradans, 2009-2015



Changes in Health Insurance Coverage, All Ages, Region 13, 2013-2015






Uninsured Rate by Health Statistics Region, 2015





Underinsurance in Region 13, 2013-2015













CHAS: How It Was Fielded



Who: 10,136 randomly selected households

What: Twenty-minute telephone survey

When: Between March 2 and June 26, 2015

Where: Statewide, divided among 21 Health Statistics Regions

Why: To gather information that can inform policy-making and help measure health reform efforts
