

2019 Session: Colorado Health Institute Bill Tracking List

Final Version

House bills are listed first (in order of introduction) and are followed by Senate bills.

Status options: Gov. Signed, Referred Measure, Failed in Committee, Laid Over/No Action, Gov. Veto*

The 2019 session featured 123 fewer bills than the prior session, but a markedly higher success rate.

- Total bills tracked by CHI during 2019 session: **138** (86 House bills and 52 Senate bills)
- Success rate for health bills tracked by CHI: **80 percent** (111 bills passed out of 138 tracked)
- Success rate for all bills introduced in 2019 session: **77 percent** (460 passed out of 598 introduced)
