

## 2020 Session: Colorado Health Institute Bill Tracking List

### 2020 Session By the Numbers

- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2020 session featured just **84 working days**, down from the normal 120 days.
- Legislators **introduced 651 total bills**, up from 598 bills in 2019.
- **51% of all bills passed**, down from 77% in 2019.
- **CHI tracked 219 bills** in 2020 (140 House bills, 75 Senate bills, and 4 resolutions). Of the bills that CHI tracked, 47% passed.
