About the Advancing Breastfeeding in Colorado Project

Advancing Breastfeeding in Colorado (ABC) is a regional project based in the Denver metro area that also offers resources for partners statewide.

ABC seeks to reduce health disparities and improve overall health in Colorado by creating a seamless system of lactation support for parents and families at their jobs, in child care settings and medical offices, and in their communities. It is supported by a three-year grant from the Cancer, Cardiovascular and Chronic Pulmonary Disease (CCPD) Grants Program. Work began in summer 2018 and will continue until summer 2021.

The ABC project team includes Boulder County Public Health, Denver Public Health, Jefferson County Public Health, Tri-County Health Department, and the Colorado Health Institute.
