

## Hot Issues in Health Conference Scholarship Application

Thank you for your interest in a Hot Issues in Health scholarship. To be considered for a scholarship, please read the information below, complete the application, and email it to Laura Manes at ManesL@coloradohealthinstitute.org.

We are offering scholarships to help address financial barriers to attending the conference. Full scholarships will cover the \$350 registration fee for the conference, which includes meals on Thursday and Friday. Please note that hotel accommodations are not included in the scholarship. A small number of travel stipends will be given to recipients who are traveling from at least 100 miles away.

Due to financial constraints for the Colorado Health Institute, there are a limited number of scholarships available. The following criteria will be considered when reviewing scholarship applications:

- Financial need, as an organization or as a community member with limited resources
- Members of rural-based, minority-led, and/or community-based organizations
- Learning intention of the applicant
- Early-stage professional status
- People who are bringing health in reach for Coloradans
- Those who work outside of traditional health care, i.e. for environmental, housing, or education organizations

Scholarship applications will be reviewed beginning Monday, October 22, 2018.

## Hot Issues in Health Scholarship Recipient Responsibilities

Scholarship recipients agree to the following duties and responsibilities:

- Volunteer at the Hot Issues in Health conference, which may include assisting with set-up and registration, supporting social media efforts during the event, acting as a breakout session room host, or taking notes during group sessions. The volunteer assignment will be developed in advance of the event and will involve approximately one to four hours of time.
- Write a reflection paragraph or create a video about their Hot Issues in Health experience after
  the conference and provide two photos from the event for the Colorado Health Institute to
  share on its newsletter and/or social media feeds.
