





#### HSR 19: Race and Ethnicity




#### HSR 19: Income Levels



#### Children 2-14 Who Are Overweight or Obese











## HSR 19: Health Insurance Types, 2012




### HSR 19: Health Insurance Projections, 2016


# HSR 19: Eligible But Not Enrolled In Public Insurance Programs
