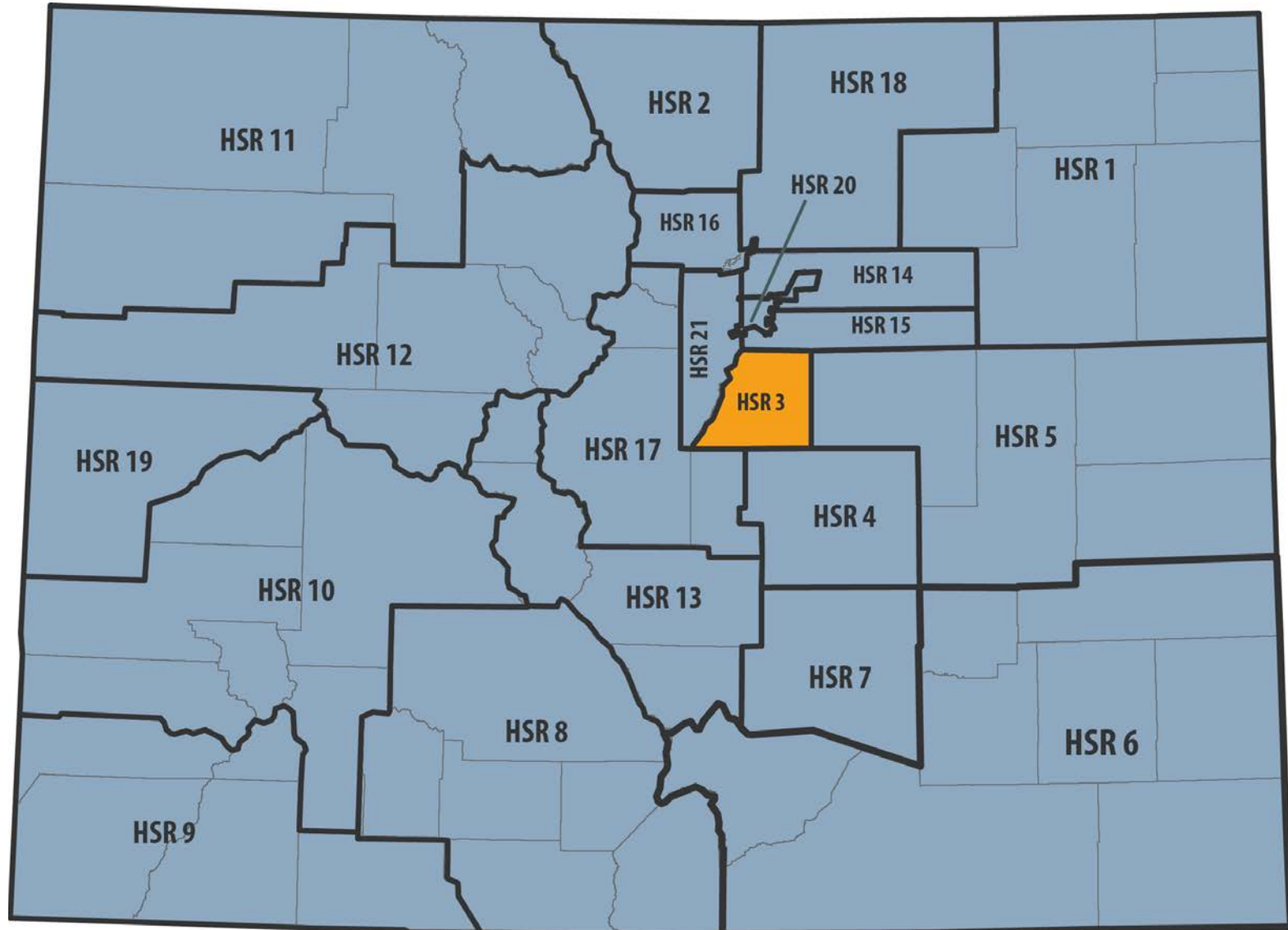

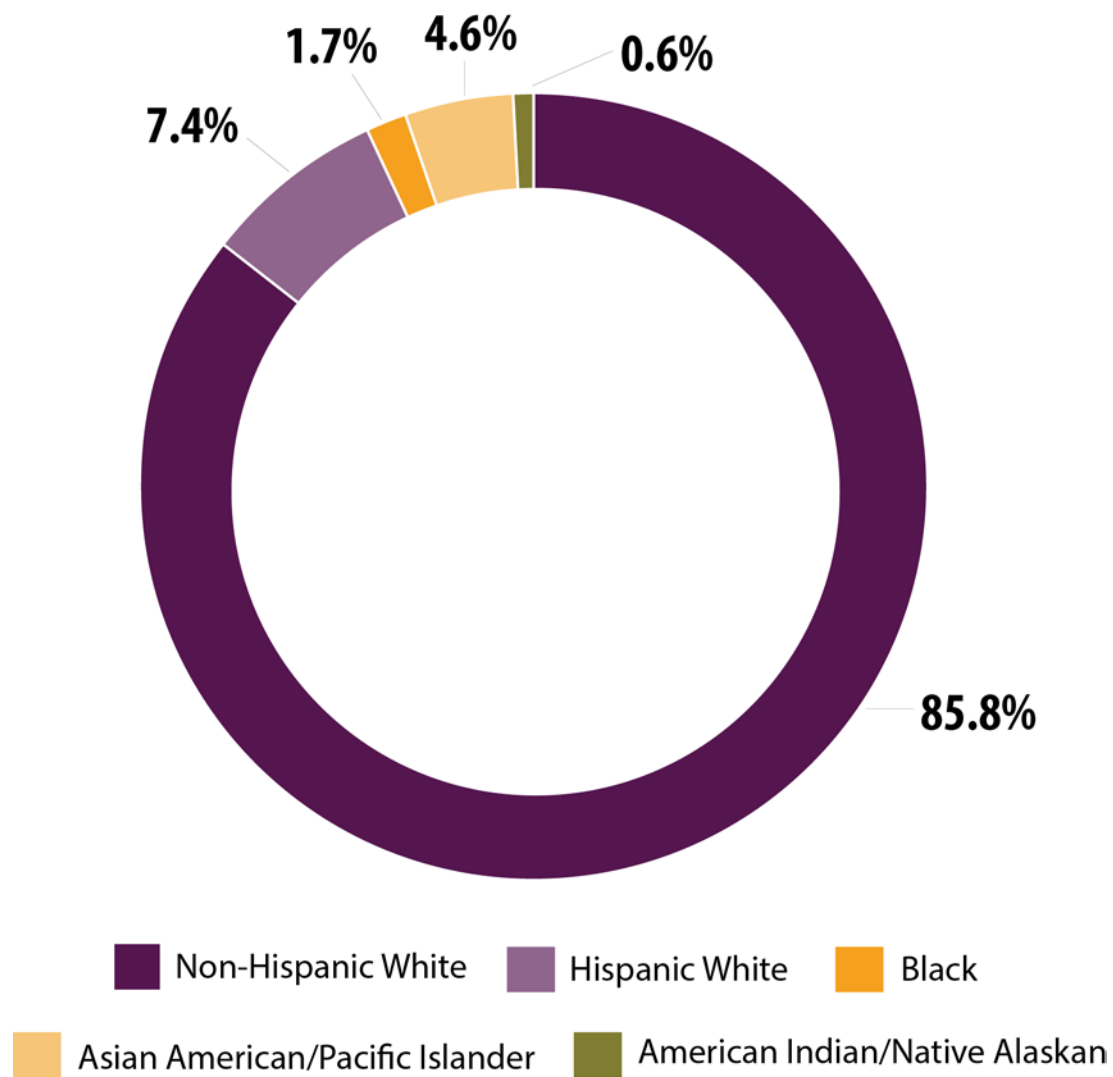

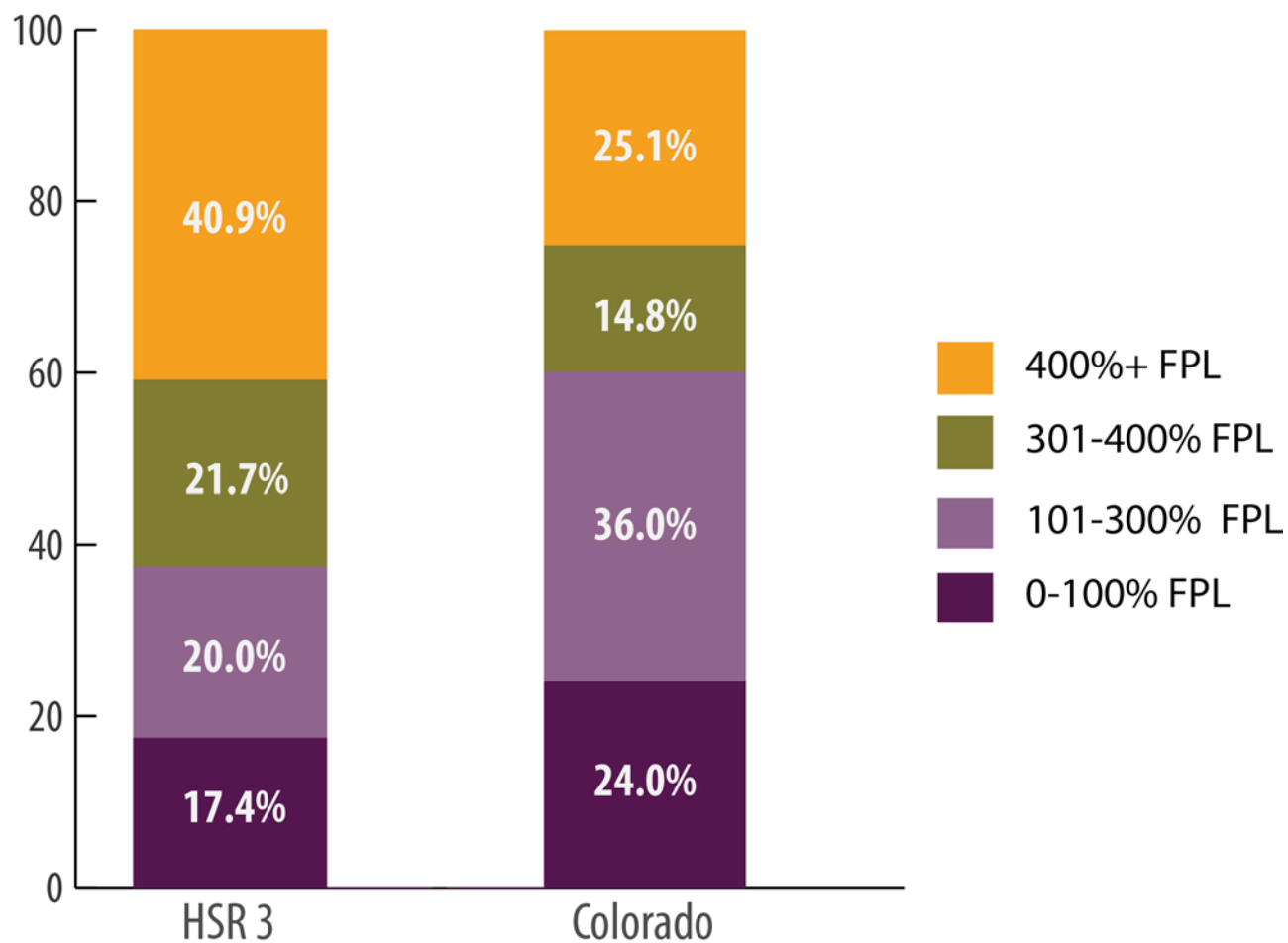

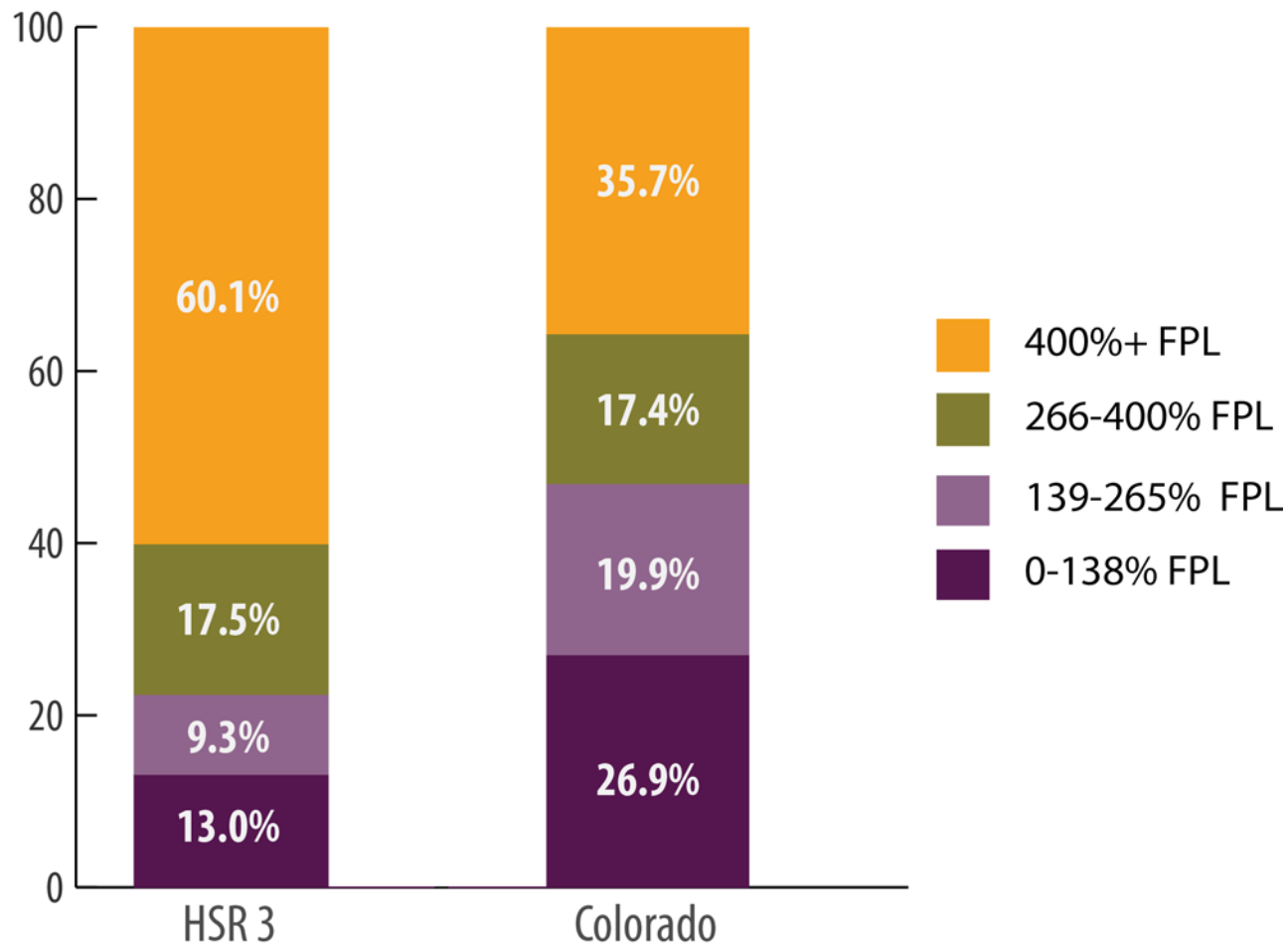
HSR 3: Race and Ethnicity

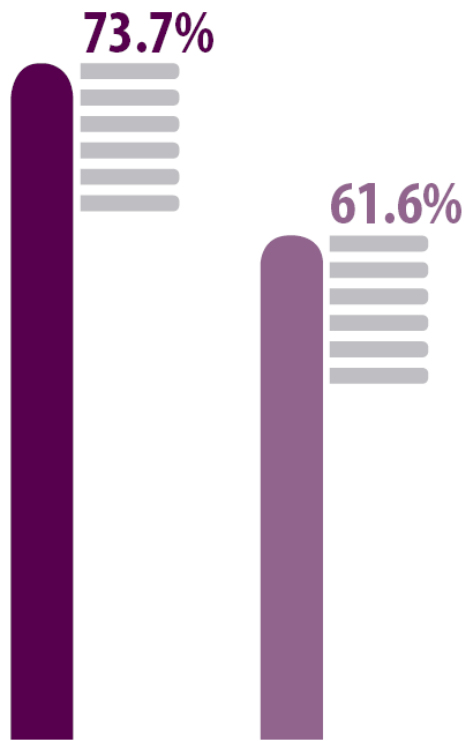

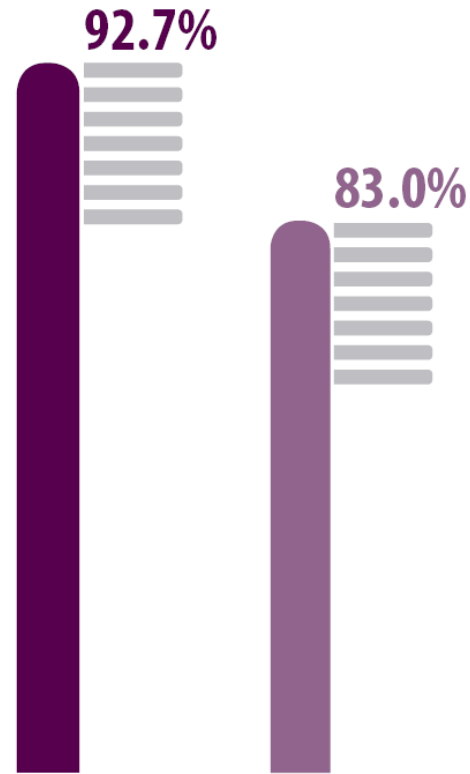


HSR 3: Oral Health

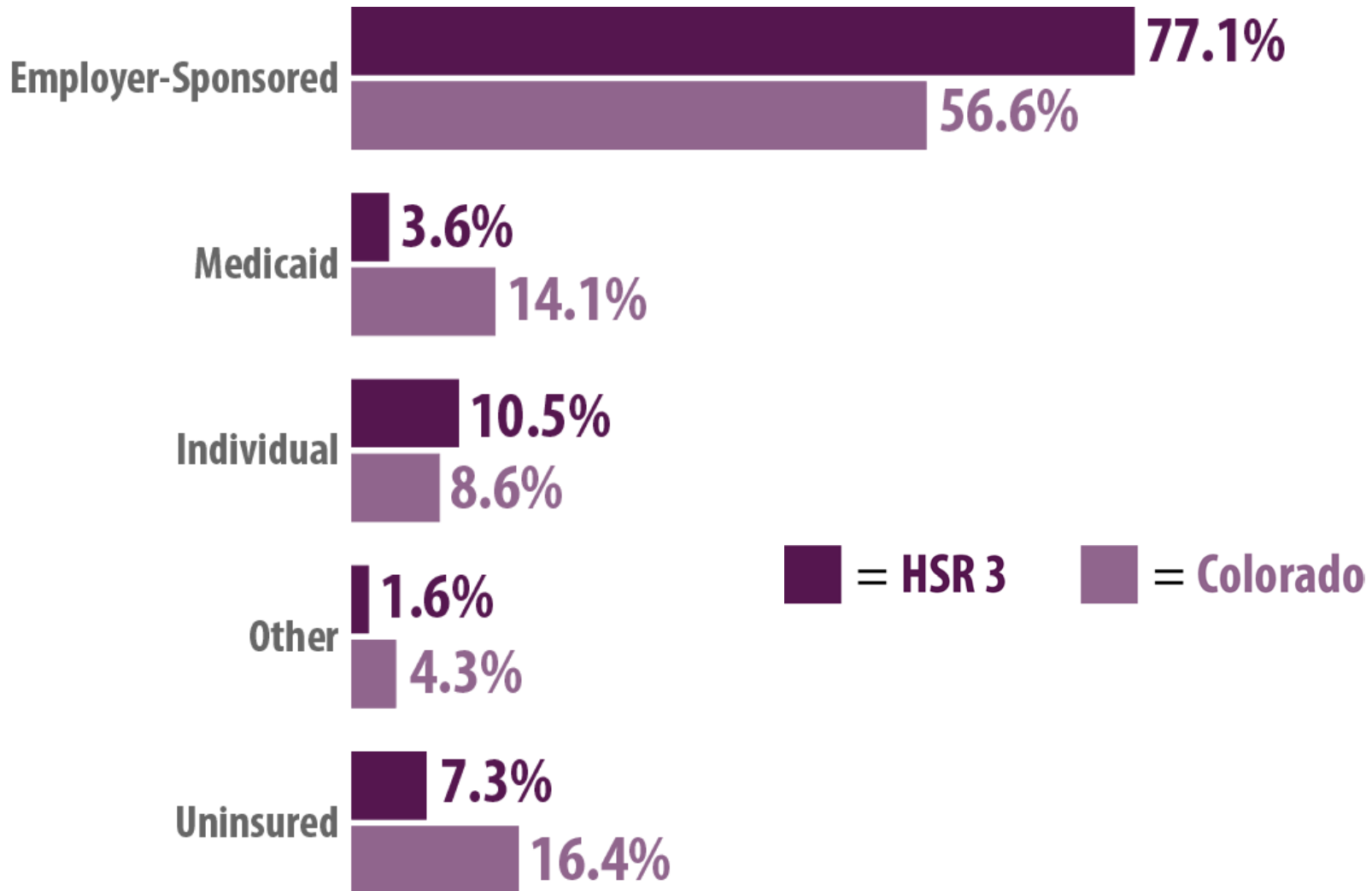

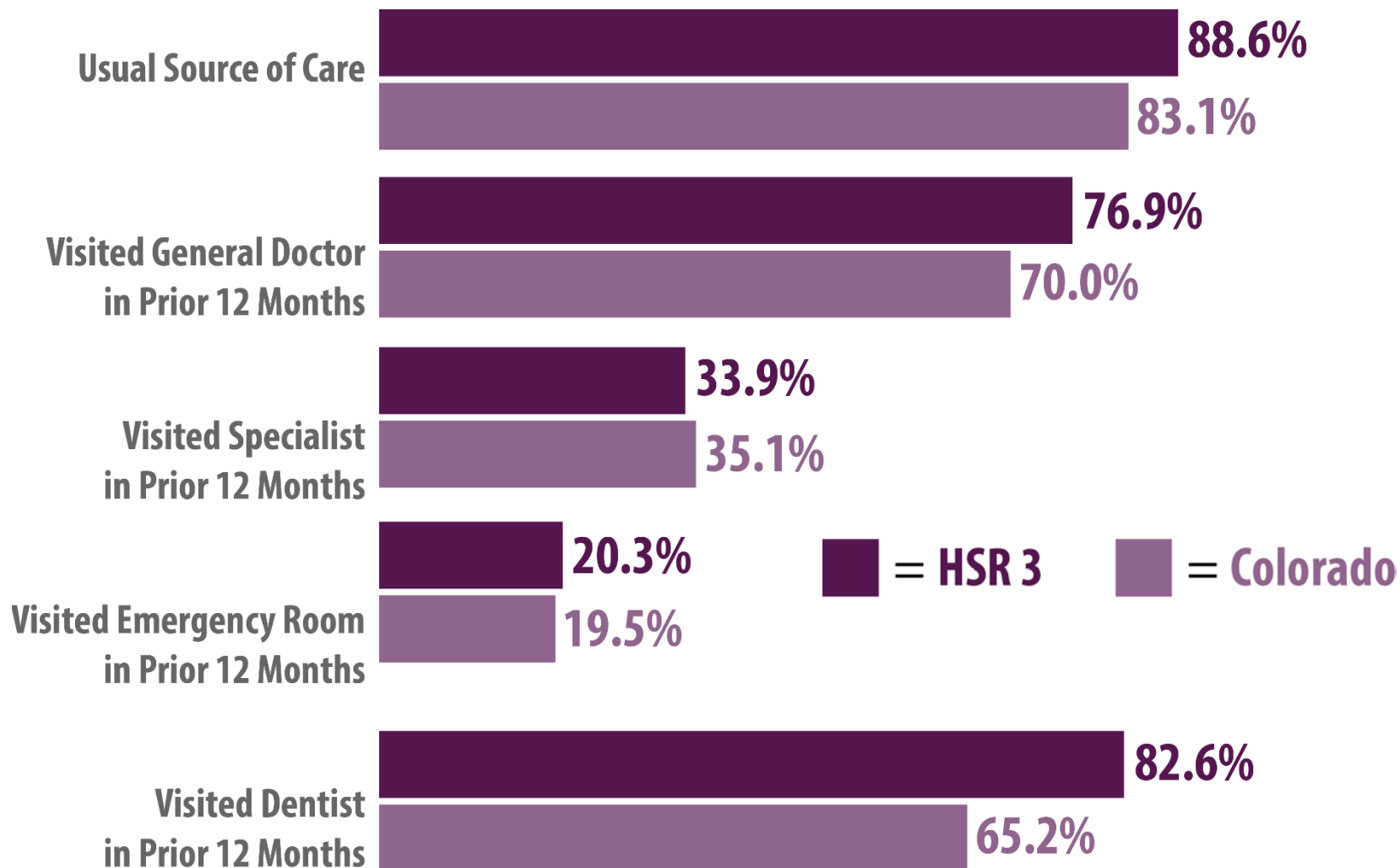
