

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
Source of Health Insurance Coverage, 2013










Population Age 65 and Over, 1900-2050

Physician Orders for Life Sustaining Treatment (POLST)




POLST is an approach to end-of-life planning emphasizing:

- advance care planning conversations between patients, health care professionals, and loved ones
- shared decision-making between a patient and his/her health care professional about the care the patient would like to receive at the end of his/her life, and
- ensuring patient wishes are honored

Per Capita Health Spending of OECD Countries, 2012






Federal Spending on Health Care Programs



Percentage of Gross Domestic Product




Medicaid Spending Breakdown, 2012





Medicaid Spending per Enrollee, 2010*







Adjusted average state health plan employee-only premiums by state, 2013



State OPEB Liabilities of \$613B as of 2012 are only 6.1% Funded






Prison Population Aging

Percentage change in sentenced prison populations by age group





