

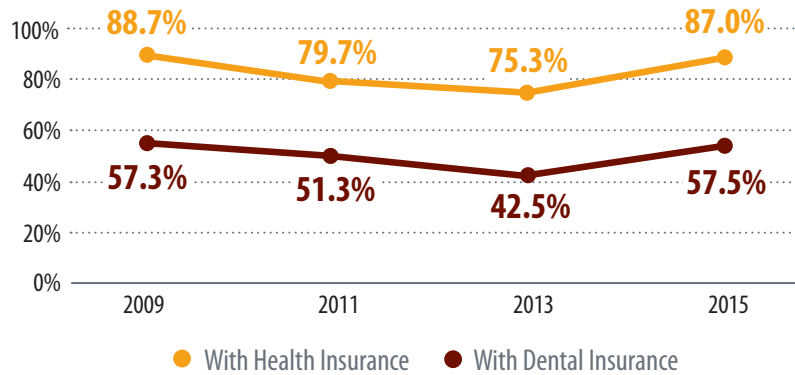

With Insurance, 2009-2015

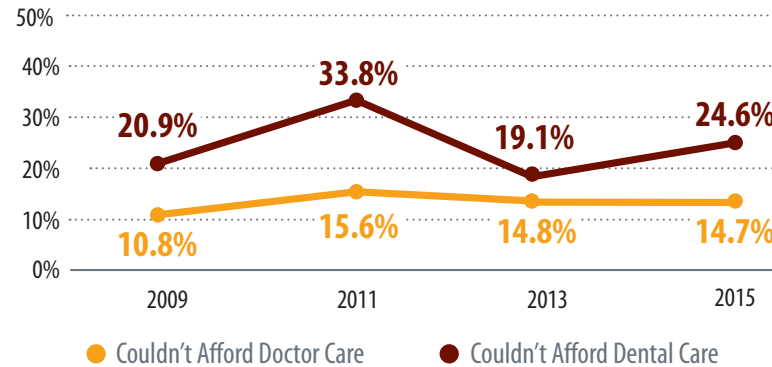


## Barriers to Care

Index Score **8.7**

## Realized Access

Index Score **6.7**

When people obtain preventive services, it's a good indication they have access to care. But hospitalizations or emergency room visits may indicate inadequate access.

Well-child visits in the past year for those under 19 years



Received prenatal care in first trimester **91.6%**

Pap test in the past three years for women aged 18+ **80.2%**

Mammogram in the past two years for women aged 50+ **71.4%**

Colonoscopy or sigmoidoscopy at any time for people aged 50+ **63.9%**
